Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing only four people. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. Today, Cascade is one of the top worldwide manufacturers in the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. All through the final 60 years, the trade of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade presently continues to develop as the best supplier of lift truck accessories and numerous related items. The company feels confident in their skill to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the world market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, fabricating and promoting hydraulic attachments. Construction was finished in 1956 on a new office to be able to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total staff reached 180 staff and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Corpus Christi a second production plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Corpus Christi, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are made globally thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is built to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in blades.
